I-5 CLOSURE ALERT

The Oregon Department of Transportation began a \$23.3 million construction project to rehabilitate I-5 in Portland, Oregon last year.

As part of that work, freeway reconstruction between the Fremont Bridge and Holladay Street will require closure of I-5 for about 12 weekends beginning July 2001. Work <u>may not</u> be on consecutive weekends.

Work will begin in the northbound lanes first. Southbound activities will begin after the northbound work is done. Freeway on-ramps in the closure area will also be closed. During the 12-weekend work window, traffic will be rerouted by way of I-405 (Fremont Bridge).

The closures will take place from 10 PM Friday to 5 AM Monday.
